CAT JEHL is looking forward to introducing us to the fourteenth century English anchoress, mystic and writer, Julian of Norwich. Mother Julian experienced sixteen visions of Christ's Passion and later recorded these in her text, *Revelations of Divine Love*, the earliest surviving English language works by a woman. These revelations reassure us of the depth of God's love in the midst of creation's suffering. Julian is recognised as one of England's most important mystics equating divine love with motherly love.

Cat comes from a Catholic family and community and also belongs to a community of meditation practice taught out of a Buddhist lineage. She is interested in the meeting points of these two traditions, particularly evident in the teachings of the Christian mystics and contemplatives.
